hand paid at or before the Sealing of this instrument
did the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
and accepted did grant Bargain sell alien
release and for ever Conform unto the said
John Ward and his heirs and assigns all
that certain parcel or tract of Land situate
lying and being in the Township of Ernest Town
aforesaid containing by measurement two hundred
Acres or the same more or less being known and
described by Lot Number Twenty two in the Seventh
Concession of the said Township of Ernest Town
which said Two Hundred Acres of Land are
butted and bounded or may be otherwise known
as follows that is to say Commencing in front
of the said Concession at the South East angle
of the said Lot then North Twenty four Degrees
Thirty Minutes with One Hundred and five Chains
twenty seven Links more or less to the allowance
for Road in the Year of the said Concession, then

Hallowell Yeoman and is hereby required to be
Registered by the said John Ward the Grantee of
the said Premises in Notarp whereof I have hereunto

in the year of our Lord One Thousand eight Hun-
