the Legislature of the Province of Upper Canada for the
Public Registering of Deeds, Conveyances, Wills, and other
incumbrances which shall be made, or may affect any
Lands, Tenements or Hereditaments within the Province. An
Indenture of Bargain and Sale bearing date the twenty
fourth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and twenty five, made between James Lake of

the Township of Ernest Town, Counties of Lenox and Addington

Midland District and Province of Upper Canada, Yeoman,

of the one part, and John Lake of the same Township, Counties,

District, and Province aforesaid, of the other part, purporting to be a release

of all that certain parcel or tract of Land, situate being and being in the Town

Ship of Ernest Town in the Counties of Lenox and Addington, Midland District

and Province of Upper Canada, containing by admeasurement Fifty acres of

Land or the same more or less, being comprised of the North quarter of lot

number Nineteen in the Town of Ernest Town, which said fifty acres of Land, are better and bounded or may be otherwise

described as follows, that is to say, Commencing at a post that now is or may

be planted on the East line of said Lot, then North Twenty four degrees thirty

minutes West Twenty six Chains thirty two links, then South Sixty five degrees

thirty minutes West nineteen Chains, then South twenty four degrees thirty minutes

East twenty six Chains thirty two links, then North sixty five degrees thirty nine

minutes East nineteen Chains to the place of Beginning. Together with all
