A Memorial of a Deed of Bargain and Sale date the tenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty Nine between Christopher & Empey of the Township of Forest Town in the County of Addington in the Midland District and Dennis Lake of the Township of Portland in the County of Frontenac in the District and Province of Upper Canada the second part where in and to have the said Christopher & Empey for the Consideration of the Sum of Sixty one pounds ten Shillings of the lawful money of the Province of Upper Canada the Receipt where of is hereby acknowledged both and doth give Grant Bargain sell assign release transfer Convey and Confirm unto the said Dennis Lake his heirs and assigns all that

one parcel of land situated in the Township of Forest Town in the County of Addington in the Midland District and Province of Upper Canada consisting of the North half of Lot Number Seventeen and more or less which said One hundred acres of land are bounded as follows that is to say Commencing in front of the said lot at an angle of the said lot then South twenty five degrees and five chains twenty seven Links more or less in front of said section then South sixty five degrees and five chains more or less to the limit between Lot Number twenty one and twenty two then South twenty four degrees thirty three minutes East Sixty three chains more or less to the Centre of the said Concession then thirty minutes East thence to the said Grants per the survey and appertinances thereto to him the said Dennis Lake his heirs and assigns for ever with Covenants of Quiet Enjoyment and General Warranty and the Conditions of the above Indenture is such that the said Christopher & Empey shall pay or Cause to be paid unto the said Dennis Lake his heirs or assigns the full and just Sum of Sixty one pounds ten Shillings Currency together with lawful interest thereon from the day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty Nine with Expence attending this Indenture then this Indenture without any abatement or deduction thereof on the day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty Nine otherwise to Remain in full force and Virtue
