and whereby the said John Lake

for the consideration of

sixty two pounds, ⁱⁿ shillings

of the Lawful Money of the Province of Upper Canada,

the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath and doth give, grant, bargain, sell, assign, release, transfer, convey and confirm, unto the said Benjamin Clark his

heirs and assigns, ALL

that certain parcel or tract of Land and premises, situated, lying & being in the Township of Haldimand in the County of Northumberland in the Province aforesaid Containing by admeasurement Two hundred acres, be the same more or less being composed of Lot number twenty two, in the ninth Concession of the Said Township of Haldimand which said parcel or tract of Land is bounded and bounded or may be otherwise known as follows, (that is to say) Commencing in front of the said Concession at the South East Angle of the said lot, where a post has been planted; then North sixteen degrees West one hundred Chains, then South twenty four degrees West twenty Chains, then South sixteen degrees East, one hundred Chains, then North Seventy four degrees East twenty Chains to the place of Beginning

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said granted premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereof, to

the said Benjamin Clark his

heirs

and assigns, to their

own use forever, with COVENANTS of seizin, right to transfer, freedom from incumbrances, quiet enjoyment, and general warranty; subject, however, to the reservations and conditions contained in the original grant thereof from the Crown;
