To the Register of the County of Addington of Addington in the Midland District

a Memorial of a Deed of Bargain & Sale dated the first day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nineteen; made between John Lake Junr of the Township of Cornist Town, Town of the one part; and Barraclough Attkinson of the said Township of Cornist Town, Town of the other part wherein & whereby the said John Lake for the consideration of the sum of twenty five pounds current money of the Province of Upper Canada the receipt & payment whereof is acknowledged, hath granted sold bargained sold, released, remitted, released & confirmed unto the said Barraclough Attkinson his heirs and assigns for ever all that certain tract or parcel of land situate in the Township of Camden in the County of Lanark in the Midland District and Province of Upper Canada containing by admeasurement two hundred acres, be the same more or less (being lot number one in the fifth concession of the Township of Camden aforesaid, which said two hundred acres of land are settled & bounded or may be otherwise known as follows that is to say) commencing in front of the said concession at the south east angle of said lot, then north twenty nine degrees west one hundred & seven chains twenty seven links more or less to the allowance for Road or rear of the said concession, then south sixty one degrees west nineteen chains more or less to the limit between lot number fifty one and fifty, then south twenty nine degrees east one hundred & seven chains twenty seven links more or less to the place of beginning allowance for Road in front of the said concession, then north forty one degrees east nineteen chains more or less to the place of beginning together with all the woods, ways, waters and water courses, thereon lying & being. To have and to hold the tract or parcel of land with all the privileges and appurtenances thereof, unto him the said Barraclough Attkinson his heirs and assigns to their own use for ever. Which Deed is witnessed by Jacob Van Bledk, and William Blough both of the Township of Cornist Town, Town of, and this Memorial thereof is hereby required to be registered by me Barraclough Attkinson the Grantor aforesaid pursuant to law.
