Twenty third day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand  
eight hundred and twenty eight, Between John S. Weston of  
the Township of Ernest Town in the Midland District and  
Governor of Upper Canada, Governor of the one part, and  
Leah Lake, widow of the late John Lake of Ernest Town, de  
ceased, of the other part; wherein and whereby the said John  
Weston for the Consideration of the sum of One hundred  
pounds of the lawful Money of the Province of Upper  
Canada, to him in hand paid by the said Leah Lake, the  
Receipt and payment of which are acknowledged, hath  
granted, Bargained, Sold, Aliened, Released, and Con

I Johnston Walker of  
the Township of Ernest Town  
Keeper do hereby Certify that  
Governor hath satisfied all money  
due upon a certain Mortgage made by  
one John S. Weston late of the Town  
ship of Ernest Town Governor to one  
Leah Lake of the same place spinster  
bearing date the 25<sup>th</sup> day of February  
A.D. 1828 and Registered at one  
o'clock in the afternoon of the 21<sup>st</sup> day of  
March following and assigned by the  
said Leah Lake to one Leah Lake  
late of the said Township of Ernest Town  
Governor on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of July A.D. 1832  
Which said Assignment was Regis  
tered at one o'clock in the afternoon  
of the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of October then following  
and assigned by the said Leah Lake  
to the said Johnston Walker on the  
day of September A.D. 1834 and that  
such Mortgage is therefore discharged

her heirs and assigns; all that Certain tract or  
parcel of land situate in the Township of Ernest Town in the Incorporated Counties  
of Midland District and Governor of Upper Canada  
containing Eighty six acres, be the same more or less  
the East half of lot number thirty in the fourth  
range of said Township, which said Eighty six acres of land are  
more or less otherwise known as follows, that is to say, Commencing  
at the Centre of said Lot, then  
running East, seventy Chains twenty seven links,  
thirty nine minutes, East, nine Chains fifty links, then  
running West, seventy Chains twenty seven links,  
thirty nine minutes, then South sixty five degrees thirty minutes  
more or less to the place of Beginning. To Have and  
to hold the said premises with all the privileges and  
advantages therein, right to transfer freedom from  
indenture and general Warranty; Subject however to  
the Covenants contained in the original Grants thereof  
and subject also to be void if the said John S. Weston  
or assigns shall well and truly pay or cause  
to be paid to the said Leah Lake her Executors, administrators, or assigns  
the sum of One hundred pounds of the lawful Money of the Province  
of Upper Canada with lawful Interest for the same on or before the  
first day of March one thousand  
eight hundred and forty, the aforesaid  
sum, and to be paid annually on the first  
day of March in every  
succeeding Year, until the principal is paid  
and until default shall happen to be made in the  
payments
