To the Register of the County of Addington in the  
Midland District. A Memorial of the proceeds  
of the last Will and Testament of John Lake, late of  
Ernest Town in the said District deceased, in so far  
as the same relates to the Lands therein mentioned situated  
in the County of Addington, in the words and form following  
I, the said John Lake, first I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife  
Sarah Lake, the two West Rooms of my dwelling house  
and the Closer Shop in the rear of these, and the East half  
of the Garden, and an Equal privilege of the Cow gate  
and the West half of the Wood House and an Equal privilege  
of the Collee, and the privilege of a passage through the  
Wicket to the Collee and in one third part of my Farm  
situate near, and one third part of the Barn and six Bar  
-nildiers, to be divided and set of to her by my Executors  
to her own use and benefit, and I further give and bequeath  
unto my son John Lake, his Heirs and their Heirs or Heir at Law, as the  
Case may be for Ever, my above mentioned house, that Farm, being Comp  
-osed of the last forty three perches of Lot No twenty and the North  
one fourth part of Lot Number Nineteen in the fourth Concession of  
Ernest Town aforesaid, with all the privileges and appurtenances  
thereunto belonging to him and his Heirs for Ever, and this Memorial  
thereof is hereby required to be Registered by me John Lake one of the  
Devisors therein mentioned pursuant to Law. In Testimony whereof  
the said John Lake has written his hand and seal the sixteenth  
day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred  
and twenty eight.
