the Crown Wherefore your Petitioner prays

that your Excellency may be Pleased to Grant
Her two Hundred Acres of waste Lands of the Crown
and Permit Mr. John Dettler of York to be her
Agent to Locate the same and take out the Deed
When Completed and your Petitioner will ever Pray
Mary Lake

Mary Lake maketh Oath and saith
that she is the Person she Describes her self
to be in the above Petition and has never Received
any Land or Order for Land from the Crown
